Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> PSAA members may submit one original picture in any medium excluding photography that was done within the last 3 years. Entries have to be hung in the Pines Shores Gallery.
Non Professional	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Member has not sold more than 4 major works over \$100 each or lesser paintings that have totaled over \$400 any given year. Member does not teach or demo art for pay. Member has not worked at a job as an artist. Member has not won more than 6 awards in any Art Shows. Member has not had work selected in 2 or more Juried art shows. Member does not have (or has held) the status of a Signature, Full or equally high membership at any other Art Organization.

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Pine Shores Art Association Hanging Guidelines for Participation in the Novice Show

Your painting will not be accepted if the following guidelines are not followed:

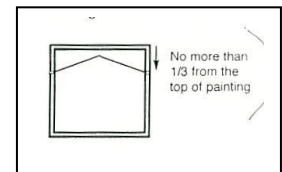
- Entry must be an original!
- They cannot be products of workshops, classes, or any other supervised gathering either at Pine Shores or any other art association.
- Artwork cannot be a copy of someone else's painting. They cannot duplicate a picture from a magazine, calendar, internet or other commercially published work.
- Any collage must be from member's own work. Pieces of newspapers, magazines, internet prints, etc do not qualify.

- Matting must be white or off-white. No colored mats.
- A colored ¼ inch inner mat is acceptable.
- Unframed canvas paintings must have gallery finish (no tape or staples showing). The sides must be a continuation of the painting or painted black only.

- Entry must not exceed 32" x 40" including mat and frame.
- In lieu of glass, Plexiglas must be used on all paintings larger than 20" x 26".
- Badly joined frames, smudged mats, smeared glass, and ragged, wavy, or over cut mat corners will not be accepted.

- Our hanging system requires that screw eyes be placed a 1/3 of the way from the top of the frame. Wire hanging only (no sawtooth hangers).
- Wire should be just slightly taut. Wrap wire ends with tape.
- Metal frames must have proper hangers (no clips) with wire.

- Entry previously exhibited in a PSAA Show will not be accepted.
- Entry must have been completed within the last three (3) years.
- Entry must remain on display in the gallery for the duration of the show.

Any work left after close of exhibition will be stored at the owner's risk. Works not retrieved within 3 months of final date of exhibition will be considered Association donations and may be disposed of as determined by action of the Board of Trustees.
