POLICIES FOR CLASSES AND WORKSHOPS (2018)

To foster art instruction, appreciation, and inspiration to its members and the public, PSAA engages regionally and nationally recognized artists to conduct classes and workshops in various media. For workshops where tuition is \$155 or more, a deposit of \$100 must accompany the registration or enrollment is not completed. For classes with tuitions from \$100 to \$155, a \$55 deposit is required. Full payment must be received by 30 days prior to the class start date. If withdrawal is prior to 30 days from the class start date, any monies paid, less a \$40 service fee, will be refunded. Pine Shores Art Association policy standard is that there will be no refunds given for withdrawals from classes for **Out-Of-Town instructors** within 30 days of the class start date. If a class fails to meet the required minimum enrollment, the workshop will be canceled and full refunds issued. If a student withdraws from the class within the 30-day period, and a replacement is found, the student will receive a refund minus a \$40 service/cancellation charge. If a replacement cannot be found, no refund will be issued.

For **local instructors**, there is a maximum and minimum enrollment set by the instructor and program committee. A minimum of eight (8) paid students is required ten (10) days prior to the start date or the workshop will be cancelled and full refunds issued. PSAA assumes no liability for non-refundable expenses related to workshop cancellations or schedule changes.

DROP-IN ART SESSIONS

These sessions do not include formal instruction but provide a chance to draw or paint among your peers. The only fees are model fees, where applicable. Otherwise, these sessions are free of charge to members.

Portrait Session – Sundays: 1:00 – 3:00 PM except holiday weekends and scheduled receptions. Small model fee.

Portrait Session – Mondays: 7:00 – 9:00 PM except general meeting night, library lectures, and holidays. Small model fee.

Pastels – Tuesdays – 7:00 to 9:00 PM unless previously scheduled class or workshop. No fee.

Artists Helping Artists - Painting Session – Oil/Acrylic – Wednesdays 2:30 - 4:30 PM except holidays. No fee.

Do Your Own Thing – Wednesdays: 10:00 AM – 2:30 PM except holidays or when gallery hangings, classes, etc. are scheduled. Members may draw or paint whatever they choose in any medium. No fee. Main calendar is posted on the elevator door of PSAA.

Life Drawing – Thursdays: 7:00 – 9:00 PM except holidays. An undraped model is provided. Small model fee.
