We’ll have PSAA sale tents out front...inside your paintings will be on the walls and tables will display your 3-D handcrafts. Santa’s out back in our North Pole parking lot, with a horse and carriage ride, vendor tents, and Pine Shores artist demos & children’s craft tables.

- Painting subjects should be winter, holiday, or Tuckerton – (i.e. “Deck the Walls”, but all for sale.) 2 paintings per artist for gallery walls. More paintings for the day on tent walls.
- Along with fine art and 3-D work, nice, handcrafted holiday items (ornaments, cards, etc.) can be offered for sale.
- Member artwork will be for sale inside on walls and tables, and outside in tents on the front lawn. (Tents are shared by all the artists.)
- To be involved, artists must be on site or arrange for an onsite friend to handle their sales. (PSAA is not involved in selling the art.)
- 20 artists can participate, first come, first served. Inside unsold paintings and crafts will be on exhibit until February 2. (Sales continue by contacting the artist. A contact sheet will be made available to visitors.)
- No fees, no commissions.
